

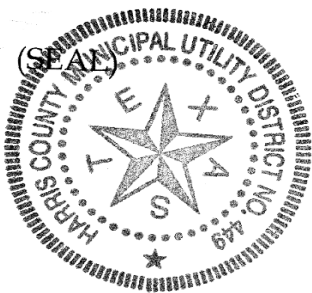
NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 449

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 449 will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, April 9, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, Comal Conference Room**, Houston, Texas 77027, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including approval of Depository Pledge Agreements, payment of bills, and opening of bank accounts, if appropriate.
4. Tax Assessor/Collector report, including payment of the bills on the tax account, approval of Depository Pledge Agreements, and requests for estimates of taxable value.
5. Garbage and recycling matters, including consider Second Amendment to Residential Solid Waste Collection Contract.
6. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance;
 - b. conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment;
 - c. amend Rate Order, if appropriate; and
 - d. garbage collection matters and take appropriate action.
7. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
8. Maintenance of detention ponds and District facility sites, including proposals for additional work.
9. Security report, including:
 - a. authorize installation of additional cameras, if appropriate.
10. Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:
 - a. installation of pedestrian crossings at Royal Amber Lane and Gold Cheyenne Way;
 - b. review Emergency Preparedness Plan and authorizing filing of updates, if necessary;

- c. approve easements and agreements; and
 - d. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction of additional projects.
11. Parks and recreational facilities matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:
- a. Ventana East Detention Trails;
 - b. Ventana Lakes East Dog Park, including landscape shielding;
 - c. Ventana Lakes East Drill Site;
 - d. Ventana Lakes East Park;
 - e. Porter Ranch Detention Pond Amenity project; and
 - f. lighting of park land.
12. Request from Paetow High School for safety gates and authorize appropriate action, including letter agreement for same.
13. Development matters.
14. Communication and website matters, including consideration of proposals and authorize appropriate action.
15. Meeting schedule and items for inclusion on the next agenda.
16. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
17. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
